

CAMEROON: GAS TO ENERGY PROJECT



As with other African countries, Cameroon is in desperate need of energy, particularly electricity to support both industrial and commercial development, as well as to improve the quality of life for its citizens. The northwestern coast of Cameroon has a significant gas potential, associated with oil and gas development in the delta of the Niger River (Nigeria). Euroil signed a concession with the Cameroon government to develop a series of fields in the Rio Muni Basin and bring the gas ashore to generate electricity. **Land & Sea Environmental Consultants Ltd.**, in association with Buursink and Assoc., were retained to prepare the EIA to meet the guidelines of the World Bank and the U.S. Overseas Private Investment Corp. Project aspects included: (a) offshore gas field exploration, (b) placement of jack-up rigs for exploration and recovery, (c) marine pipeline, (d) shore facilities, (e) gas to energy generation facility and (f) transmission facilities.
