

CARIBBEAN: ORGANIZATION OF EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES: SOLID AND SHIP-GENERATED WASTE MANAGEMENT PROJECT: MODEL POLICY, LEGISLATION AND REGULATIONS STUDY



OECS, using a World Bank loan, wanted to develop regulatory and policy mechanisms to address problems with solid and ship wastes in the member island countries. The project area included Antigua/Barbuda, St. Kitts/Nevis, Dominica, Saint Lucia, St. Vincent and the Grenadines and Grenada.

As part of the Component Study team led by deRomilly & deRomilly Ltd., **Land & Sea Environmental Consultants Ltd./OCL Group** assessed ship-generated wastes in commercial ports and yacht marinas in the six study countries, and assisted in preparation of policies and regulations to promote environmentally sustainable waste management. The Study output will provide for a revised *Solid Waste Management Act*, a new *Marine Pollution Management Act* and associated regulations.
